Holiday Gala Canapés

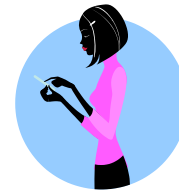

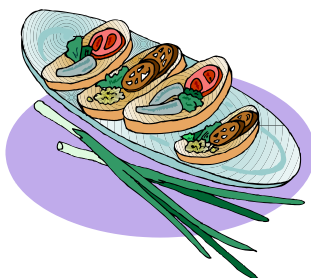
